CANON 8

THE PROVINCIAL SYNOD OF "CANADA"

- 1. An election of delegates and substitute delegates of each order to represent this Diocese in the Provincial Synod of 'Canada' shall take place at noon on the second day of the session of Synod immediately preceding a meeting of the Provincial Synod.
- 2. The provisions of the Canon 7 on the election of delegates to the General Synod, with the exception of Section 3 thereof providing for the election of a resident of Prince Edward Island, shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to the delegates and substitute delegates to the Provincial Synod, their election and certification.
- 3. The clerical and lay delegates attending a session of the Provincial Synod shall make a report in writing to the next session of the Diocesan Synod respecting the principal business transacted at the meeting of said Provincial Synod.

[This note is not a part of Canon 8. 'Mutatis mutandis' is commonly translated and understood to mean, 'Those things being exchanged which the sense requires should be exchanged.']
